SILVER FLICKA well positioned from outset, came four wide into lane, responded to handling, came between foes in late going, got up in time. FAST AND QUICK stalked leaders from outset, moved nearest pace mid stretch, went gamely to wire only to be outfinished. SHADY ERL allowed to settle in stride early, commenced bid racing six wide into stretch, finished with a solid belated mid track rally for show spot. TIM'S PICK was never far back, lacked the needed response in drive. UNOME'S KANDIMAN hustled to front, set pace along rail to mid stretch, gave way in late going. FULL FLEDGE RUMOR failed to menace. FREQUENT was never a factor. CHIMINO showed little. BIG CASH DEAL was outrun. DEEP ROCK DAN chased pace for half, faded. BANK ON CARSON was never close. WILD DEER was always far back.
