LIL MISSKNOWITALL stalked the early pace from the inside, altered outside entering the turn, responded to duel through the drive and outfinished rivals late. LADY GDANSKI well placed from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, altered outside for the drive, responded but could not reach the winner. PLAYGIRL PROSPECT outrun early, circled rivals on the turn, responded and had good energy late. DUSTY'S PLAYER dueled from the outside early, remained engaged through the turn, battled through the drive but tired late. OH SO NOTISED went evenly. KANAKAVALI was never close. TAPPIN 'N PREACHIN dueled from the inside and tired. AFLEET WIND chased the early pace and gave way.
