DEFLATIONARY FEARS rated off early pace while along rail, moved forward entering far turn, responded along rail into stretch, came off rail mid stretch, rallied and got up in time. DUZY JASKO was allowed to settle in stride early, commenced bid racing four wide into stretch, responded to handling, unable to reach winner but gained second spot in an game try. GUIDING HAND dueled along inside from start, responded to gain nod at the half, came five wide into stretch, went gamely under pressure before tiring late. BARRAAQ raced in middle of pack on the outside into stretch, had no rally. WILD FOR GLORY stalked leaders into stretch, lacked response when asked. WILD IVAN raced along inside, failed to menace. TRICKYEXPECTATIONS was not a factor. LOST FORTY chased pace for three quarters, gave way. VALID MESSAGE was always outrun. TRAIN HEIST dueled on the outside of rivals for half, stopped, eased, crossed finish.
