AT THE BRINK was never far back outside rivals, commenced bid racing three wide into stretch, responded to take over mid stretch, kept to task, remained

clear to wire. LEADING WEST within striking distance along inside early, swung four wide into stretch, moved up to be nearest leader mid stretch, went gamely before weakening in late going. DARK CORNER allowed to settle after working way to inside, finished with a solid belated rail rally to gain show spot. TWOFISTED well back at the half, swung five wide into stretch, finished with a belated mid track rally. INDIAN HOSS stalked leaders while on the outside into stretch, tired. SMART 'N SALTY saved ground while forwardly positioned for half, to no avail. H K'S VICTORY along inside in back to stretch, failed to menace. HEZA CARSON CITY trailed early, showed little. MARCO DE ESPERANZA wide of rivals while in back for half, not a factor. HIGH STAKES SILVER was never a threat. WOOD TAK dueled while between foes for half, faded. J C'S BIGCATCH hustled to front, set pace for half along rail, dropped back. MANDATE MAKER was outrun. FATHER ROCKY stalked the early leader while on the outside, faded steadily after quarter mile.
