CHECK MY HALO NAU was allowed to settle in stride racing along inside for half, commenced bid racing three wide into stretch, responded to steady handling in drive, got up in time. TAPPIN 'N PREACHIN broke alertly to front, opened up a long lead before half, went gamely when pressure in drive but couldn't last. WHEELING WINI chased leaders into stretch, went gamely in drive before weakening in late going. DIXIE HEARTH stalked leaders into stretch, had no rally. MAYMEISTER failed to menace. STORMY LYPARD raced in middle of pack early, lacked response. GRAND OPRY was not a factor. IRISH SOUL never threatened. MISS SNOW NOSE was outrun.
