Footnotes

FLY THE RED EYE well placed from the outside, reached a forward position entering the second turn, dueled through the second turn, gained a short advantage at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. STAND WATIE dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged entering the second turn, held a forward position entering the drive but could not keep pace. G FROST unhurried early, steadily advanced outside, made a bid entering the second turn but could only gain the show. JAGGED EDGE chased the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn but could not keep pace. BANDIT EYES pressed the early pace from the inside, held a forward position for the drive but had nothing left. A SCARS VALUE dueled from between foes for the early lead, remained engaged through the second turn but tired in the drive. MR. GOLD BAR could only pass tired ones. TEMPLE BAR was no factor. HUNT FOR ROSES was no threat. KENNETT MO had little interest. CAPARELLI was no menace. CANNONEER showed little.
