**Footnotes**

BIG SKY BEVIE up close outside early, tracked the pace up the backstretch, responded to pressure entering the second turn, gained a clear advantage entering the stretch, remained well clear at the eighth pole and was under steady urging late to be well clear. SOUTHERN RANSOM unhurried early while inside, advanced entering the second turn, remained inside for the drive but was too late while clearly second best. SHISHKBOB HAY chased the early pace from the inside, rushed up the backstretch to force the pace, made a bid entering the stretch but flattened out. PEABODY JO well placed from between foes, had no late response. KEOSNATIVE could only pass tired ones. NO. ONE SUSPECT allowed to settle early, advanced outside up the backstretch, responded to pressure entering the stretch, lacked room upper stretch when in tight, then finished evenly. SLEWDEGRACE was no factor. HALO'S SUNSET chased the pace outside and tired. MAKINGTHEGRADE was no menace. LADY SOLDIER broke well from the outside to set the early pace but gave way.
