CON SAY ONE racing in middle of pack, had no rally. VALENTINE GAMBLE saved ground to no avail. DEFENDER'S WORD was never a factor. ECTON'S MONSTER chased pace for half, gave way. THE ROCK E F stalked leaders for half, faded. OLD RULES was outrun.
