TEXAS BLING chased leader from outset, responded to steady urging into lane, gained nod mid stretch, drew off in late going. RULE BREAKER was never far back, came three wide when making bid into stretch, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, no match for winner late but held gamely to second spot. EVAN'S CALLING broke to front, set pace into stretch, went gamely before weakening along rail in late going. SMOKEY DEPUTY came three wide from middle of pack when making bid into lane, loomed danger mid stretch, flattened out. KIPPER DAN well back during early running, passed tiring foes in lane. TAKE A LITTLE NOTE saved ground to no avail. MONK E SEE was never a factor. BIN TOUGH was outrun. STRATEGIC PLAYER was never close, eased in lane, crossed finish. RYALS vied with early leaders for half, stopped, eased in lane, crossed finish.
