WORLD CUP was allowed to settle for half, circled five wide when making bid into stretch, responded to take over and draw off in late going. BALM stalked leaders from outset, came three wide when making bid into stretch, moved up to be neare4st leader mid stretch, went gamely but unable to match strides with winner late. CHAMPIONSHIP GOLD trailed to stretch, four wide into stretch, finished well with belated mid track rally. HOT SUMMER SQUALL well back to stretch, passed tiring foes in lane. MAYMEISTER raced in middle of pack, had no rally racing along rail. LET'S DREAM AGAIN chased pace for three quarters, gave way. CREPE MYRTLE forwardly positioned along rail to stretch, faded. DOMINIKA (MEX) broke to front, set pace for three quarters, dropped back. DEVIL IN DIAMONDS was never a serious threat.
