RARE COURAGE was allowed to settle in stride during first half of running, commenced circled rivals leaving far turn, came five wide into stretch, responded to urging, finished with a burst of energy, got up in time. GIN'S BAILEY dueled from outset, responded to gain narrow edge mid stretch, went gamely to wire only to be outfinished in the end. WIMBLETON'S FIRE broke to front, held clear advantage the half, went gamely along rail to mid stretch, tired. PEANUT JR stalked leaders throughout, had no rally. NOAH AND O raced in middle of pack throughout, had no rally. PRINCE RILLIAN was never far back, raced four wide into lane, lacked response when asked in drive. JENNY'S TOUCH was not a factor. TOMMY TWO STROKE forwardly positioned for half, faded. BILL'S HAT TRICK was never a threat. ILLUMINATED OKIE trailed throughout.
