UNO MAS outrun early, was outrun entering the turn, altered outside for the drive, responded and was just up the final stride. CHICKS A FLYIN chased the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, gained a clear margin deep stretch but was caught the final stride. GRAND SLAM ANDRE pressed the early pace from the inside, altered outside for the drive, responded and was gaining late. HENSHIN HERO broke sharp from between foes to gain the early margin, remained well clear entering the turn, held a forward position for the drive but shortened stride late. DARK RULER chased the early pace outside but had nothing left. TEMPO FIVE was no factor. RANGE WAR forced the early pace outside and tired.
