SKEETER SLEW broke alertly to front, rated well with a clear lead into stretch, responded to mild urging in drive, remained clear to wire. A J'S CAT rated off early pace, came four wide when making bid into stretch, went gamely but unable to reach winner and settled for second best. Q P SLEW was never far back racing along rail into stretch, lacked rally in drive. ESAU hung wide from outset while not far back, came five wide into stretch, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, flattened out. NO LAK OF SMARTS raced along inside in back early, moved up into stretch, lacked response in drive. POLLY'S PRO chased pace along inside for half, gave way. EUROFLAIR forwardly positioned along inside into stretch, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, gave way. OKIE PROSPECT well back from start, eight wide into stretch, no factor. SUNSHINE PUMPER wide from start, five wide into lane, showed little. WAR WAGON was never a threat. DR. DARON STREET came to inside after start, outrun. B ART TWO was never close. LAID BACK OKIE forward positioned for quarter mile, faded steadily thereafter. STATE CRAFT JR. always outrun.
