ROLL CALL dueled from the inside for the early lead, continued to battle up the backstretch, remained engaged through the second turn, gained a clear margin at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. IT'S ON HOLMES stalked the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded when asked but could not reach the winner. DIA PERFECTO (MEX) chased the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the second turn but could not sustain the effort. BATTLE MARCH unhurried early from the outside, crept closer entering the second turn, responded and finished well. SPANISH PRIDE pressed the early pace from between foes, responded and had a mild late gain. PRINCE A. J. forced the early pace from the inside but had nothing left. WOLFMANLEX dueled from the outside and tired. LOOKIN HECTIC was no factor. PASS EM KRISTIN was never close. DARBY'S LIGHTNING had a steady fade. ANYMORE DANCE chased the early pace and gave way.
