FAST AND QUICK stalked the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, made a bid entering the drive, dueled through the drive and was just up the final stride. LUCKY MOON well placed from between foes, inched closer entering the turn, made a bid to duel through the drive but was outfinished. ALLNFASTTIME far back early, advanced outside entering the turn, responded but was outfinished. MERRY MAX dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, battled through the drive but could not keep pace. CHASIN THE GIRLS could only improve position. AMERICA'SGRANDSLAM went evenly. FLAMING JAWS was no factor. FORREST GUMP OK up close from the inside, faded. SOUTHERN L K chased the early pace outside and tired. DR. DARON STREET dueled from between foes and tired. AIRMAN MAYBERRY was never close.
