HONOUR OUR TROOPS was allowed to settle in stride early, worked way forwardly along rail during run down backstretch, came off rail into stretch, responded to steady urging, wore down leader in late going. GONDOLIERI (CHI) dueled for lead from start, responded to gain advantage at the half, went gamely to wire before weakening in late stages. COACH QUE was never far back, finished with a mild inside rally in lane. HEZA WILD GUY forwardly positioned throughout, lacked rally. MINGO MOHAWK failed to menace. BIG TEX vied for lead to three quarter pole, gave way.
