LAMENT LIL POSEY rated off early pace, came three wide when making bid into stretch, responded to steady urging to take command and draw clear in late going. SPANISH PRINCESS pressed pace for half, responded to gain narrow edge mid stretch, went gamely before weakening in late going. SURELY hustled to front, set pace for half, went gamely under pressure to mid stretch, tired. WILD SPARKLE well back at the half, improved position in lane. NEGRA RAPIDA raced in middle of pack, lacked response when asked. BUDDHAFUL SONG failed to menace. PIONEER WAY was not a factor. MYSTERIOUS CHANT was outrun. SERVICE FIRST chased leaders for half, faded steadily thereafter.
