Footnotes

FIRST ACT allowed to settle early, tracked the pace up the backstretch, inched closer entering the second turn, responded when asked and was just up the final stride. LE FLYING MONKEY unhurried early, steadily advanced outside up the backstretch, reached a forward position entering the second turn, responded to pressure to gain a short advantage deep stretch but was caught the final stride. HEAVENLY SHILOH chased the early pace from the outside, held a forward position entering the second turn, dueled through the drive but could not match strides. PERFECT REFLECTION up close early from the outside, dueled through the second turn, remained forward for the drive but could not keep pace. BOLD STEPHEN stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded but was too late. BRIAN G well placed from the inside, had no late response. HIPOCRISY broke sharp from between foes to set the early pace then tired in the drive. MOUNTAIN GULCH could only pass tired ones. RENEWING was no factor. BANDINI'S STAR forced the pace and tired. OKLAHOMA HERO pressed the early pace and tired. HOT DIGGITY DOG had a steady fade.
