Footnotes

VALLEY FOG dueled along rail from outset, responded to steady urging during stretch drive, gained command and drew off in late going. JACKRABBIT FAST hustled to front, set pace with narrow margin to mid stretch, went gamely under pressure but unable to match strides with winner late. STRAIGHT FLASH was allowed to settle during first half, circled five wide into stretch, responded to handling while racing mid stretch, finished well but too late. KIPSANDY was never far back, raced four wide into stretch, finished with a mild rally while mid track. SILVERBDANCING stalked leaders to mid stretch, had no rally. HOYA failed to menace. GOLDANDSILVER was never a factor. UNOME'S KANDIMAN raced in middle of pack on the outside, lacked response when asked. DAAREB was never a threat. HERECOMESTHERAIN saved ground to no avail. M M EXPRESS was outrun. RANGE WAR vied, dropped back, pulled up in distress, vanned off.
