SHERP broke to front, rated well with a clear lead into stretch, responded to mild urging in drive and maintained safe margin to wire. WILSON RIVER was never far back along rail, responded to handling along rail in drive and finished well to gain second spot. FLASHY TORO chased pace throughout, lacked needed late kick in drive. CAT'S CLASSY RIDER raced in middle of pack, finished with a mild inside rally. BACKSTABBER well back early, passed tiring foes in lane. LAKE CREEK forwardly positioned outside rivals into stretch, had no rally. MOORE WEST chased pace for half, gave way. PENNEY N A PRAYER was not a factor. NINE FRIENDS was not a factor. MISTER H forwardly positioned outside rivals for half, faded. NAPI was never a threat. BULLERINA KID was outrun.
