LOTTO TICKET rated off pace, commenced bid racing three wide into lane, responded to take over mid stretch, kept to task and remained clear to wire. MISS PARTY ARTIE was allowed to settle in stride early, circled far turn, three wide into stretch, rallied but unable to reach winner and settled for second best. K D QUEEN well back at the half, circled three wide into stretch, finished with a mild belated rally, got up for show spot. ADDISON TRAIL was allowed to settle early, came four wide when making bid into stretch, finished with a belated rally. VERY SPECIAL LADY saved ground to no avail. AHSOBURBANK dueled along rail from start, responded to gain clear advantage at the half, gave way in lane. AUNT GLO hustled to front, dueled on the outside of rivals for three quarters, faded. MY SILVER LULLABY was always outrun.
