LINGERLONGER within striking distance outside rivals from start, came around rivals three wide into lane, responded to take over mid stretch, went unchallenged, ridden out to wire. ALPHA AND OMEGA broke to front, set pace into stretch, no match for winner when challenged mid stretch, but clear best of others. BIG SUGAR HIGH came from middle of pack five wide into lane, finished with a mild rally to gain the third spot. COMPENDIUM chased pace into stretch, gave way. SHAKETHEINCREDIBLE well back at the half, improved position in lane. D'S LUCKY GRAY failed to menace. JIGGER BOSS was not a factor. ROLLONCAT was outrun. BEAR O vied for early lead, faded steadily after quarter mile. DA BELLDOZER was through early, pulled up in apparent distress entering stretch, vanned off.
