LODED WITH ROSES stalked pace from outset, no match for winner but went gamely to nail second spot. MACKEEES LAST TRICK was never far back along rail, outfinished for the second spot. ELISHA JOY trailed early, moved up along inside into stretch, finished with a mild belated rally. SOVIET DOLL saved ground, had no rally. KINGAROO chased pace for half, gave way. BELLA BABE forwardly positioned along inside for quarter mile, faded. LOADOFWYATT was always outrun.
