AIRMAN MAYBERRY within striking distance outside rivals, came three wide into stretch, responded to take over mid stretch, kept to task, remained clear

to wire. DEB'S EXPENSE ACC was never far back outside foes, came five wide into stretch, went gamely but unable to reach winner but well clear for second spot. SUNDAY'S ON THE WAY stalked leaders along inside from outset, lacked response when asked. BERNIE'S LEGACY forwardly positioned outside rivals to stretch, lacked response when asked. KORONA KAT hustled to front, set pace for half, gave way. PLAIN CAT well back at the half, showed little. NORTH LODGE forwardly positioned along inside for half, gave way. DEMON'S DEVILLE raced in middle of pack along rail, not a factor. CAT MAN JACK trailed for half, improved position. I'M OUTA HERE was never a threat. OCHELATA TAH DAH forwardly positioned outside rivals for quarter mile, faded. DEEP ROCK DAN raced in middle of pack for quarter mile, dropped back. HIGH HILL ROAD dueled on the outside of rival for quarter mile, faded steadily after half. UNCLE RIP was always outrun.
