RED LEAD pressed pace from outset outside foe, responded to strong handling during stretch drive to gain command and draw off in late going. BILLY TWO HATS broke to front, set pace into stretch, went gamely under pressure in drive before weakening in late going. BIG SON OF A GUN was allowed to settle in stride for half, circled leaving far turn, came three wide into stretch, responded to handling while racing mid track, finished well but too late. DAKOTA GYPSY was never far back along inside, finished with mild rally. BENWILL raced in middle of pack, had no rally. DON DULCE stalked leaders while within striking distance entering stretch, gave way in lane. KATE'S MAIN MAN saved ground to no avail. QUE DESEO was never a threat. LITTLE WAGON was outrun. FREEZE YOUR KELA forwardly positioned wide of rivals to stretch, faded.
