MILITARY MAJOR rated off early pace, came five wide when making bid into stretch, responded to strong handling in drive and proved best in game effort. REAL DANDY was allowed to settle, commenced bid six wide into stretch, finished well with belated bid while racing mid track. GOLDEN RAINBOW was never far back, moved up between foes into stretch, dueled throughout drive and outfinished a good try. LUMBRE sent to front, dueled for lead throughout, weakened in late going. KILATES KISS chased pace along rail to stretch, tired. FLYING EAGLE forward positioned to stretch, had no rally. LUCKY BID close up outside foes to stretch, faltered in drive. JAZZY GALLOP was not a factor. TRICKY SLEW along rail in contention for half, faded. LEAR FORCE was never a threat.
