VAN NISTELROOY GAL within striking distance along inside from outset, swung six wide into stretch, responded to steady urging while racing mid track, got up in final strides. CROSSFIREHURRICANE stalked leaders while racing along rail from outset, responded to gain clear advantage mid stretch, went

gamely under pressure to wire only to be outnodded in the end. MIMI'S REWARD came five wide from middle of pack into stretch, responded to steady handling, finished well with belated mid track rally but too late. SPEEDY BUTTERFLY was allowed to settle in stride early, came five wide into stretch, finished with a solid mid track rally but too late. K D CHEYENNE saved ground while forwardly positioned into stretch, went gamely before weakening late in drive. PLEASANT GAL came from middle of pack along inside, finished with a mile rally. DREAMS ON THE WIND well back early, moved up along rail into lane, finished with a belated rail rally. PLAYATRICK raced in middle of pack, lacked response when asked. SHADYS BACK hustled to front along rail, dueled for half, gave way. ONE CAR FUNERAL wide from outset, never a factor. APPEALING VISION hustled to front before half, faded steadily thereafter. SECRET WHISPER was never a threat. ANGEL'S ABOVE US was outrun. BELEN CUVEE was never close, eased in lane, crossed finish.
