J J'S INDY broke alertly to front, set pace with clear advantage into stretch, responded to mild urging throughout stretch drive, remained clear to wire. PLEASANT STORM rated off early pace, commenced bid racing four wide, went gamely but unable to reach winner but clear best of others. MOTION APPROVED chased pace into stretch, tired. SOME QUICK was never far back racing along rail, moved up to loom danger into stretch, flattened out. PACAR stalked leaders into stretch, gave way. GARBU'S SON raced in middle of pack for three quarters, faded. SHARE CROPPER was never a factor. RUN OFF RIVER was never a threat. DAVILAR was always outrun.
