SCORING SPREE well placed from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive and was clear late under steady urging. SLEEVE stalked the early pace from between foes, advanced entering the second turn, responded but could only gain the place. DAUGHTRY outrun early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded entering the drive and found his best stride too late. BADGER BO pressed the early pace from between foes, remained forward for the drive but could not keep pace. GREEN CARD JAMES forced the early pace from the inside but had nothing left for the drive. MOONING YOU up close early, tracked the pace up the backstretch, held a forward position for the drive but tired in the drive. OPEN HEAVEN broke sharp from between foes to gain a clear early margin remained clear up the backstretch, continued to show the way through the second turn then tired. GOOD TO GREAT forced the early pace then tired. APRIL'S PICTURE was no factor. MAKE THE GRADE was no threat. PLENTY LUCKY was never close.
