**Footnotes**

SOLAR CHARGE stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the turn, altered outside for the drive and was along in time. GOLD COYOTE dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, dueled through the drive but could not match strides. DUCKY DRAKE outrun early, advanced outside, responded and was gaining late. SILENT PIPE chased the early pace from the inside, held a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. FLAT BLACK dueled from the outside early, battled through the turn then tired in the drive.
