Footnotes

RANGER B. dueled along rail from outset, responded to steady urging during drive to wire, drew clear in late going. OKLAHOMA RISING well back at the half, came four wide into stretch, finished well with a strong belated rally, gained on leader late. TURKEY HUNTER dueled for lead from start, gained narrow edge at the half, went gamely under pressure before weakening in late going. SUN CAN RUN stalked leaders from outset, engaged leaders into stretch, went gamely before tiring in late going. PAWNEE RULER well positioned after dropped rail into stretch, lacked needed response in drive. BRUSHY CREEK dueled on the outside of rivals for half, gave way. S C KING well back at the half, improved position. LOST MY MIND was not a factor. SLUG BUG was not a threat. LUCKY CONN came six wide from middle of pack into stretch, faded. HERE COMES MARV forwardly positioned outside rivals for half, dropped

back. WHIRLING CREST was always outrun.
