LITTLE WAGON was allowed to settle during early running, moved up heading into far turn, took over entering stretch, kept to task, remained clear to wire. ALWAYSWITHAPPROVAL was never far back, moved up to engage leaders into stretch, flattened out in drive but clearly the best of others. ALERIC stalked leaders into stretch, lacked response. WALLY'S CHOICE trailed for half, came four wide into stretch, not a factor. EVADE hustled to front, set pace for half, gave way in lane. ELUSIVE SCHEMES chased pace for half, faded steadily thereafter.
