DONE DECIDING within striking distance outside rivals from outset, came around three wide of rivals into lane, responded to gain nod mid stretch, kept to urging and drew off in late going. GOOBER was never far back, commenced bid racing three wide into stretch, responded to strong handling while mid

stretch, finished well to gain second spot. SILENT HERO forwardly positioned outside rivals from outset, came wide into stretch when making bid, lacked the needed response in drive. GRAND ALI dueled on the outside of foe from start, responded to gain nod at the half, went gamely into stretch, tired in late going. CAT'S A SMOKIN stalked leaders along rail into lane, had no rally. LOGANWORTH wide of rivals from outset, failed to menace. COOLER KING well back wide of rivals for half, not a factor. SULLEYMAN TIME well back at the half, swung seven wide into stretch, no threat. PAPA JACK showed little. ELITE BUCKAROO dueled for early lead along inside, faded steadily after half. BELLY UP was never close, bolted into stretch. AGGIE APPEAL well back from outset, carried outward entering stretch. LIME RUNNER took up sharply far turn, avoiding fallen rival. EXALTADO dueled from outset along rail, broke down leaving far turn, euthanized.
