KATHERINE'S HALO away in good order from the outside to chase the early pace, inched closer up the backstretch, reached a forward position entering the second turn, gained command and steadily drew clear. SPOOKY OKIE dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained a forward factor entering the stretch but could not keep pace. KATELYN'S MIST well placed from the inside early, gradually inched closer entering the second turn, remained inside for the drive but was too late. STELLAR CLOUD up close outside, had no late response. NATIVE PENNY unhurried early, advanced entering the second turn, responded and finished well. FOR LUCK could only pass tired ones. RUNNING BETSY was no threat. RED RED RAIDER was no factor. TROPICAL CANTESA dueled from the outside and gave way. LORA LORA LORA was never close. A P ALERT showed little. DOENY GHOST close up early, bolted entering the second turn and was eased.
