FRIO FLYER dueled while racing between from outset, responded to handling to gain narrow edge into stretch, kept to task and drew off in late going. GRAY FLYER stalked leaders from outset, commenced bit three wide into stretch, no match for winner but well clear of others in the end. TREE STORM dueled along the rail into stretch, gave way in late going. BAD BOY CHARLIE dueled while racing between foes to stretch, faded. JET G'S ONE well back early, raced five wide into lane, no menace. MAMPO (MEX) was never a factor. QUANAH JOHN never threatened. ISLES OF GOLD dueled on the outside of rivals from start, came four wide into stretch, dropped back in lane. MOUNTAIN TALK dwelt at the break, outrun.
