Footnotes

CARTOUCHE within striking distance outside rivals from outset, commenced bid racing three wide into stretch, responded to strong handling in drive, got up in time. HURRICANE DAY rated off early pace racing along rail, came off rail four wide into stretch, responded to handling and just missed getting to winner in a game try. TRICKY CAUSEWAY chased pace into stretch, went gamely in drive before weakening late. VALID MESSAGE was allowed to settle early, commenced bid racing five wide into stretch, finished with a belated mid track bid. BARRAAQ was unprepared start, closed gap. NINIAN well back into stretch, failed to menace. FREE SAILING hustled to front, set pace into stretch, faded in late going. HUNTERWOOD POINT raced in middle of pack, not a factor. JUMP TO THE CHASE was not a threat. KENTUCKY MILE was never far back along inside, moved up to loom danger into stretch, faded in lane.

PHARME LEGEND stalked leaders into stretch, dropped back in lane. ALERIC was outrun.
