HOT SUMMER SQUALL trailed for half, came three wide when making bid into stretch, responded to strong handling while between rivals, finished with energy but too late. FRIVOLOUS ALEX was never far back, came four wide into stretch, responded to handling to loom danger mid stretch, hung in late going. OUI OUI ANN was allowed to settle along rail for half, came off rail three wide into stretch, finished with a mild rally. AIRE OF VICTORY raced in middle of pack into stretch, lacked response. LAUREN BROOKE stalked leaders along rail into stretch, gave way. KATE ROYALE was not a factor. PRETTY CHARMING chased pace to stretch, faded. UP IN CLASS hustled to front, set pace for three quarters, stopped.
