BALM was never far back, swung five wide into stretch, when making bid, responded to handling, gained command and drew clear late. IT'SNOTYOUIT'SME well positioned along rail from outset, responded to handling but was unable to reach winner in drive, gamely held unto second spot. BELLE MUSE trailed for half, moved up along inside into stretch, responded to handling, finished well but too late. JET'S ATTACK dueled on the outside of rivals from start, responded to handling, gained narrow edge mid stretch, tired. GIBSON CRYSTAL well back at the half, circled six wide into stretch, improved position. PERFECT TAP failed to menace. BEST CREDENTIALS was not a factor. RIDEM UP was never a threat. MOST DARLING hustled to front, went gamely into stretch, forced to check when ;in tight sixteenth pole, dropped back thereafter.
