GUNSMOKE N stalked the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced entering the turn, responded when sat down for the drive, gained a clear margin mid stretch and was clear late while kept to task. PARADISE CITY well placed from between foes early, made a bid entering the drive and found his best stride too late. MARS N STARS dueled from between foes for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, held a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. VIVALAFREDDIE chased the early pace from the inside, altered outside entering the turn and finished well. HOT TICKET ITEM dueled from the outside for the early lead, battled through the turn but tired in the drive. HAPPYTOBEKING dueled from between foes and tired. XTRA SPICY dueled from between foes and tired. NOMBREHARDTIMES was no factor. DANDY DIAMOND had a steady fade. SOONER SUNSET showed little.
