TOCCT'S CHARM stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive to gain a clear margin, and was well clear while kept to task. TOES THE LINE broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, held a forward position entering the drive but was no match for the winner while clearly second best. PURE PANICK outrun early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded but was no match for the top two. GRAEME PLACE pressed the early pace from the inside, crept closer entering the second turn and finished well. MOUNTAIN FIGHTER forced the early pace outside and tired. B. B. KING OF SCAT chased the early pace inside but had nothing left. FUN GUN had little interest. MARBLETON had a steady fade. TOES THE LINE WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM SECOND TO UNPLACED FOR A MEDICATION VIOLATION.
