OUI OUI ANN stalked the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the second turn, made a bid entering the drive, dueled through the drive and was up in time the final yards. JUST MAID allowed to settle early, advanced inside up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, responded and was getting to the winner. BIN QUIET dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, battled through the second turn, held a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. LUVTHAT D'ORO well placed from the inside early, dropped back entering the second turn, responded when asked and was gaining late. CAME HOME LATE forced the early pace from the inside, remained forward but had nothing left. SWEET VICTORY ROSE was no factor. ACANELLA was no threat. ROCKPORT LOVER dueled from the outside and tired. GRANDIOSE forced the early pace outside, made a bid entering the drive but flattened out. EVIL ATTITUDE had a steady fade.
