**Footnotes**

STRATEGIC LEADER rated off early pace along rail, moved up along inside leaving far turn, came off rail four wide into stretch, responded to steady handling, took over and surged clear late. PASS THE BISCUITS chased pace into stretch, responded to gain slight nod mid stretch, no match late for winner but gamely held onto second spot. ARTIC HEAT stalked leaders from outset, raced four wide into stretch, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, flattened out. MOTION APPROVED was never far back racing along rail, responded to look threat along rail mid stretch, faltered. MARCO DE ESPERANZA raced in middle of pack along inside into stretch, had no rally. MARGO'S BOY sent to front, set pace for three quarters, gave way. OKLAHOMA TRADITION raced wide, failed to menace. GEORGE TAYLOR was not a factor. PATTON ON SPEED was always outrun.
