BULLCREEKROAD stalked the early pace from the inside, crept closer entering the turn, altered outside for the drive, dueled through the drive and outfinished rivals the final yards. FLY MR MAN dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, battled with the winner through the drive but was outfinished. KITTEN IN A PINCH chased the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the turn, responded and was gaining late. RIGGAN dueled from the inside for the early lead, battled through the turn, remained forward for the drive but had nothing left. KORONA KAT went evenly. VALID SPECTACLE was no factor. JIMMIE THE JET showed little. PLEASANT JONES was never close. FORTUITY had a steady fade.
