TED'S FOLLY outrun early, advanced inside entering the turn, altered outside for the drive, responded and was just up the final stride. STAR'S VALENTINO forced the early pace from between foes, remained in a forward position entering the drive, dueled through the drive with Z ROCKSTAR, gained a short margin over that one deep stretch but was caught the final strides. Z ROCKSTAR pressed the early pace from the outside, held a forward position entering the turn, dueled through the drive but could not match strides. KONAWA SLEW chased the early pace from the inside, remained forward for the drive but could not keep pace. HARPER COUNTY well placed from the inside, made a bid entering the drive but could not sustain the effort. K COMPANY was no factor. RUMORSBOUTME was no threat. GERONIMOS CADILLAC broke sharp from between foes to set the early pace and gave way. SEA MASTER pressed the early pace outside and stopped.
