CAPTURE THE FLAG forced the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the second turn, made a bid entering the drive, dueled through the drive with DON'S OKIE LUCK, put that one away at the eighth pole, was engaged by OKIE SLEW mid stretch and was just up over that one late. OKIE SLEW well placed from the inside, dropped back up the backstretch, altered outside entering the second turn, reached a striking position entering the drive, dueled with the winner but was outfinished. CONCERNED OKIE far back early, advanced outside entering the second turn, made a bid along the rail but was outfinished in a game effort. STRATEGIC LEADER outrun early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded and finished well. OKIETATE was no factor. DON'S OKIE LUCK broke sharp from between foes to gain a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, held a forward position entering the drive but tired. TI TOWNSHIP was no threat. MOTION APPROVED was finished after a half.
