Footnotes

CHIEF TWO SPOTS well back for half, moved up forwardly along inside into far turn, rallied sharply along rail into stretch, took over mid stretch, unchallenged to wire while being ridden out. MOUNTAIN FIGHTER was never far back outside rivals, came four wide into stretch when making bid, no match for winner in drive but clearly best of others. JOHNNY BLACKFOOT stalked leaders from outset, moved up to loom danger into stretch, gave way.

ADDIE OKIE well back at the half, moved up along rail into stretch, finished with a mild inside rally. RED RIVER EXCHANGE well back at the half, came four wide when making bid into stretch, flattened out. DANCIN PEAK forwardly positioned along inside into stretch, gave way. ALLEYS GENERAL well back outside rivals into stretch, improved position. MORGAN'S EDGE failed to menace. BOBBY BE GOLD came three wide from middle of pack to gain narrow advantage into stretch, dropped back in lane. P L STOP LIGHT chased pace from outset along inside, moved up to engage leader three quarter call, dropped back suddenly. DEADWOOD DESPERADO was never a threat. TOMMY AND JOHNNY stalked leaders for half along inside, faded. GOLDEN ALIBI hustled to front, set pace for half, stopped. ULTIMATE BONUS was always outrun.
