### Footnotes

ACTION READY stalked leaders from outset, came three wide when making bid into stretch, engaged leader mid stretch, responded to steady urging to wire and prevailed in an all out effort. ANDRETTI broke to front, rated well on narrow lead into stretch, went gamely under pressure throughout long stretch drive only to be outnodded in the end. ORDINARY TIME was allowed to settle for half, commenced bid racing four wide into stretch, finished with a belated rally to gain show spot. WOULD YOU trailed early, worked way forwardly leaving far turn, finished with a mild mid track rally. LUSTERDUST forwardly positioned along inside into stretch, had no rally. DEPUTY WHY failed to menace. CHURCH HOUSE chased pace for three quarters, gave way. FLYSKYFLY was never a factor. HE'S SO PROUD forwardly positioned for half, faded. TORNADO STORM was always outrun.
