BARZEN dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, shook loose at the eighth pole and was well clear while kept to task. LESSTALKLETSRUN chased the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, altered outside for the drive but could only gain the place. KING GUSTAUFG dueled from the inside for the early lead, battled through the turn, held a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. ANNA'S STRAWBERRY stalked the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, made a bid but could not sustain the effort. BUILTLIKEABRICK outrun early, advanced inside, responded and finished well too late. NORMANDY'S MAZE went evenly. SNOWLEOPARD'SGROWL forced the early pace inside and tired. HAY GLORIOUS GIRL was no factor. DIAMOND JACK chased the early pace and tired. WALTZINGWITHWALTER had a steady fade. TO BE PRIZED had little interest. NICKABOOM was never close.
