RECKLESS JERRY chased the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded to pressure entering the drive, dueled through the drive and was clear late while under steady urging. KING CORAL unhurried early from the outside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, dueled with the winner but could not keep pace. SIXTO CALIXTO (MEX) outrun early, advanced inside entering the second turn, altered outside and had good energy late. COWTOWN PANTHER dueled from the inside early, remained engage up the backstretch, battled through the second turn but tired late. MEADOW'S REWARD was no factor. BARNEY R dueled from the outside and tired. WRANGLIN' OKIE forced the early pace and tired. GOLDANDSILVER had a steady fade.
