Footnotes

DENOVACAINE dueled on the outside of rivals from outset, responded to gain narrow edge at the half, came five wide into stretch, kept to steady urging while racing mid track, prevailed in the end. CHASIN THE GIRLS within striking distance along rail from outset, responded to handling, moved up to challenge leader mid stretch, went gamely but unable to reach winner. CANNON CLASS dueled on the outside of rivals from outset, came three wide into

lane, went gamely in drive before weakening in late going. HENRY SUNSHINE well back at the half, swung five wide into stretch, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, tired. CHIMINO stalked leaders from outset, moved up along inside to challenge pace at the half, went gamely into stretch, gave way. GLENDASBIGBOSSMAN swung seven wide from middle of pack into stretch, failed to menace. ZEROS TRICK wide from outset, not a factor. BORAX wide from start while forwardly positioned for half, gave way. BARLO wide while in back from start, showed little. BY BY BARON hustled to front, dueled for half, faded. SAUNA BOY was never a threat. PAYROLL was outrun. PLAIN PICKENS raced in middle of pack along inside for half, dropped back steadily after half.
